**Weekday Masses** (Monday - Friday): 6:30am & 8:00am  
Wednesdays: 7:00pm  
Saturdays: 9:00am

**Extraordinary Form Masses:** First & Third Fridays of every month at 7:00pm

Monday, Tuesday, & Thursday: (*Except Holy Thursday*)  
March 2 – March 31: 6:30pm – 7:00pm  
April 3 – April 11: 6:00pm – 7:00pm  
Wednesday: 6:00pm–7:00pm, and after 7:00pm Mass (*Except Ash Wednesday*)  
Friday: 6:00pm—6:30pm (*Except March 24, when Confessions are 4:30—5:00pm*)  
Saturday: *Morning*: 8:30am–8:50am, & after 9:00am Mass; *Afternoon*: 3:30pm–5:00pm  
Sunday: 1/2 hour prior to 8:45am, 10:30am & 12:15pm Masses

7:00pm: *Stations of the Cross*

7:30pm: Confessions (until the line runs out)

### Holy Saturday, April 15

*(a day of voluntary fasting and abstinence)*

12:00pm: Blessing of the Easter Baskets

1:00pm–3:00pm: Confessions

**8:30pm: Easter Vigil Mass**
