- **Requirement:** Adult Chaperones must be age 25 or older & "compliant". If you are not compliant yet, you can still become compliant in time to volunteer for WorkCamp 2016!
- Job Description: Chaperones/Crew Leaders are expected to supervise, interact with, and support a crew of 5-6 teenagers as you work together on your site throughout the week. Chaperones are role models both on and off the work-site, keeping track of your crew on site as well as taking on the role of a mentor and supervisor for the teens of your parish when we are all together before and after "work".
- Time Requirement? Chaperones / "Adult Crew Leaders" are required to attend the entire week of WorkCamp, June 25-July 1st. You should also do your best to attend St. Raymond's WorkCamp preparation meetings & events.
- There is NO COST to you other than the time you give. Your cost will be covered via fundraising in conjunction with the set budget of the Youth Apostolate. We realize the significant time commitment this entails and this is the least we can do to say THANK YOU!
- St. Raymond's must provide 1 male chaperone/crew leader for every 5 male teens & likewise for females.
- Adult Crew Leaders MUST REGISTER ONLINE BY FEBRUARY 9[™]!

"HANDY-MEN/WOMEN" A.K.A. "CONTRACTORS"

- **Description:** Handy men and/or women are known as "contractors" at WorkCamp. Their job focus is on leading the work on the sites. You *DO NOT HAVE TO BE A PROFESSIONAL CONTRACTOR* to be an amazing WorkCamp Contractor! All you need is a general knowledge of tools and "fix-it" skills, and a desire to teach teens your skills.
- **Time Requirement?** Particular days of need include the work site days, Monday (June 27th) through Thursday (June 30th), a minimum of two. Contractors are the only WorkCamp volunteers given the option to commute, though we will be serving in Shenandoah County so they also have a place to stay arranged for you at the high school and a hotel block discount option. You also have the option of joining the teens & Adult Crew Leaders for the entire week, Saturday evening (June 25th through Friday afternoon, July 1st).
- What kind of job will you get? New this year...jobs will be assigned on a first-come, first serve basis. The sooner you sign-up, the sooner you will know which type of job you will be assigned to. You may request a certain type of job (ie. Painting, repairing a deck, roofing) based on your skill set and comfort level.
- *St. Raymond's is required to bring 1 "contractor"/ "handy-man" per day for every 5 teens.*
