



Declaration of Commitment to the St. Raymond's WorkCamp Community

1. I will complete and return all paperwork and WorkCamp fees on time.
2. I will check my email regularly for any WorkCamp related updates.
3. I will be present for the **entire** WorkCamp Prep Weekend in January.
 - 6-9pm Friday January 4th
 - 8am-8pm Saturday, January 5th
 - (Snow date is January 25-26th)
4. I will be present before and after *at least* 5 of the 6 Masses during the Raffle weekend, March 2-3rd. I understand that any Mass I am not present at (before & after), other than the one I am allowed to miss, will add an additional \$25 to my total amount due for WorkCamp.
5. I will participate (either baking or selling) in at least SIX of the monthly Youth Apostolate bake sale fundraisers between now and WorkCamp.
6. I will make it a priority to attend St. Raymond's High School CCD and/or youth group on Sunday evenings and/or the bi-weekly guys/girls group on Tuesday evenings to get to know my fellow WorkCampers (teens & adult leaders).
7. I will obtain all the necessary tools and supplies (including footwear, **modest** clothing, etc.) needed for the week.
8. Beginning today, I will pray for my fellow WorkCamp missionaries, both youth and adults; including the parishioners of St. Raymond's who are supporting us. I will also pray for my crew and all those whom we will be serving.
9. I will cooperate with all the guidelines for WorkCamp and be mindful that at all times I am a representative of the Diocese of Arlington and the Catholic faith.
10. After WorkCamp, I will write a brief reflection essay about my experience and share it (2 min. or less) with the congregation after Mass.

I have read the above information, understand it and promise to comply with the responsibilities listed above. I recognize that failure to **fully** comply with these responsibilities is likely to result in forfeiture of my spot at WorkCamp.
