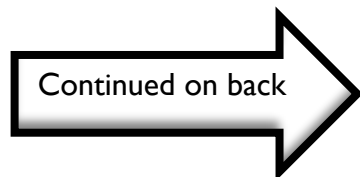

Cost:

- \$335 total due per participant.
- The total is actually \$495 cost per person, but we will fundraise (bake sales & WorkCamp Raffle) to cover \$160 of this per person.
- Please do not let money deter you from coming. Scholarship money is available. Ask Jeanne.

Fundraising:

- Fundraising helps to keep the parish informed of what we are doing and who is doing it.
- It also helps to cover the expense of our chaperones as well as other expenses, such as our team building day at Sportrock, food for our meetings, and much more.
- Most of the participant fee goes into purchasing the materials for home repairs. Some provides breakfast & dinner for the week & evening program costs.
- **Note:** The Bake Sales take the place of the Annual Yard Sale, which is no longer happening.

Community Building:

- WorkCamp is intended to be and to foster an intentional Christian community, modeled after Acts 2:42-47, *“They devoted themselves to the teaching of the apostles and to the communal life, to the breaking of the bread and to the prayers...all who believed were together and had all things in common...they ate their meals with exultation and sincerity of heart, praising God and enjoying favor with all the people. And every day the Lord added to their number those who were being saved.”*
- This intentional community is to be fostered not only while at camp, but also amongst the domestic church (our families) as well as within our parish community here at St. Raymond’s. It is a community not only comprised of those who go to WorkCamp, but that of our whole parish family.
- There is pretty much just one weekend (January 4-5th) set aside for WorkCampers to really get to know one another. This is on purpose. WorkCamp is not its own community, but rather, a part of the larger community, and so all teens attending WorkCamp are strongly encouraged to get involved in some aspect of the Youth Apostolate to continue to get to know one another.
