#### What is the Trinity of God

- According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church the Trinity is the:
  - Central mystery of Christian faith
  - Mystery of God in himself
  - Source of all other mysteries of faith
  - Light that enlightens them
  - Most fundamental and essential teaching in the "hierarchy of the truths" of faith

### What is the Trinity of God (Cont)

- It is one of the mysteries that are hidden in God which can never be known unless they are revealed by God
- A dogma of the Church teaches that all three persons of the Trinity exist for all times
- One God Three Persons
  - Three Missions
    - **Father** creator
    - **Son** redeemer
    - **Holy Spirit** sanctifier
