

PLAN TO VOTE EARLY FOR THE NOVEMBER 5 ELECTION

WHY SHOULD YOU VOTE EARLY?

Don't let illness, injury, power outages or technical problems at the polls, civil unrest, world events, voter fraud or long lines prevent you from casting your ballot.

WAYS TO VOTE EARLY

- In-Person or Curbside at any early vote location listed on the reverse page.
- Absentee

IN-PERSON Or CURBSIDE EARLY VOTING

- EARLY VOTING BEGINS SEPTEMBER 20TH (See full list of locations and schedule on the reverse page.) **Only Fairfax County registered voters** may vote early in-person. **The registration deadline is October 15.** (Registration forms and addressed envelopes are in the Narthex or online at: <https://vote.elections.virginia.gov/VoterInformation>)
- Voters must present an acceptable ID or sign an ID Confirmation Statement.
- Curbside voting is available at all early voting locations for voters aged 65 or older, or if disabled. (Park near the curbside sign and call the posted number.)
- Same-day registration (not a recommended option) is available between October 16 and November 2 at early voting locations. Voters submitting a same-day registration will vote a provisional ballot.

ABSENTEE VOTING

DO NOT MAIL IN THE COMPLETED ABSENTEE BALLOT UNLESS ABSOLUTELY NECESSARY HAND CARRY IT TO A POLLING LOCATION.

- Absentee Ballot by mail. For each election you must fill out an application, available on the Narthex Voting Table or online at <https://vote.elections.virginia.gov/VoterInformation>
- Permanent Absentee Ballot (use the above link and fill out the form). Select the Permanent Absentee Option, #4. Each election your ballot will automatically be mailed to you 45 days before the election. No one else can vote in your name since you have your ballot.

Permanent Absentee Ballot is a perfect way for your child away at school to vote.
Use the home address rather than the school address. Absentee Ballot arrives 45 days before the election.
Mail it to your student in an outer envelope. They vote the ballot and send it back to you in a separate envelope. You then drop it off at your early vote drop box. (This eliminates updating the form each year with a new school address.)

NOTE: For each of the above absentee options you may choose to:

- 1) Complete the ballot and take it to an Early Voting poll. Place it into the absentee drop box located inside the polling location. (The drop box is monitored by Election Officials since it is inside the poll and mailing is not needed.)
- 2) Decide to vote early in-person instead. You must hand-carry the unvoted ballot to a poll, give the ballot to the Election Officer and indicate you want to vote in-person instead. If you do not return the ballot, you must cast a provisional ballot.
