Description

In the Spring Sessions of our study, we will begin by completing the Book of Signs (Chapter 11) and continue into the Book of Glory (Chapters 12–21), which includes the profound Passion narrative of John's Gospel. In this study, we will delve into the mysteries and teachings of these chapters, striving to ascend the spiritual heights they reveal. Together, we will seek to read scripture as the Church Fathers and Medieval Scholastics did—with reverence and faith. The goals of this study are threefold: first, to grow in love for the Word of God; second, to practice integrating study and prayer; and third, to understand John's Gospel as both its human author and its Divine Author intended. Through this journey, we will reflect deeply on the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of Christ as presented by John, aiming to deepen our faith with reason, inspired by the soaring witness of the Evangelist.
