

Old Testament Sources

Individual scrolls

May have begun as early as 1440 BC

• The Septuagint

- Translation of Hebrew scrolls into Greek began in the 3rd Century BC
- Completed in 2nd Century BC (around 132 BC)

The Hebrew Bible

Reached its current form in the 2nd Century AD
