Primary emphasis	Traditions/movements where it is especially prominent	Characteristic idea

Several characteristic religious temptations:

- **Will without truth** → legalism or voluntarism.
- **Emotion without truth** → sentimentalism.
- **Experience without truth** → subjectivism or spiritualism.
- **Works without grace** → moralism.
- **Intellect without love** → sterile intellectualism.
