August 29 at 5 p.m. - Deadline to apply to vote by mail

September 2 - Deadline for mailed voter registration forms to be postmarked.

September 2 at 11:59 pm - Online deadline to register normally, or update registration.

September 3-6 - Same day registration available at early voting locations. Must vote provisional ballot.

September 6 at 5p.m. - Early voting closes.

September 9 - Ballot returned by mail must be postmarked by Sept. 9 and received by noon on Sept. 12.

September 9, 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. - Election Day voting at your precinct polling place. Same day registration is available at your precinct where you must vote a provisional ballot.

September 9 at 7 p.m. - Deadline to return Vote by Mail ballot in a drop box or hand deliver to Election Office.
