### ST. RAYMOND'S WORKCAMP (JUNE 17-23) REGISTRATION PACKET



### What is WorkCamp?

Arlington Diocesan WorkCamp is an intentional Christian Community that provides an experience of direct service for young people within the boundaries of the Catholic Diocese of Arlington.

Since 1990, WorkCamp has been venturing into various areas of Virginia with a twofold objective. First, we seek to provide the teens of our Diocese with an intense conversion experience through service, community, and prayer. Second, we seek to serve our fellow Virginians by making their homes warmer, safer, and drier.

During **the week of June 17–June 23**, approximately 800 teens from more than 40 Arlington Diocese parishes will share a week of prayer, service, song, adoration, confession, and fellowship.

Up to 160 crews of 5 teens, 1 or 2 adult crew leaders, and a contractor will venture out to more than 100 residences to make fellow Virginians warmer, safer, and drier. These teens will spend a large part of their week getting to know teens from other parishes along with adults who will model their Catholic faith throughout the week. In the evenings, inspiring talks, song, games, and opportunities for confession and adoration will give this group of teens the opportunity to encounter Jesus Christ. Each day, the teens and their crew will experience direct service by meeting the needs of those less fortunate right here within the boundaries of our Diocese.

#### Sample of Projects Completed During WorkCamp 2019:

- 158 crews worked in eight counties, including King George, Spotsylvania, Caroline, Stafford, and Westmoreland.
- Over 200 windows and 30 doors replaced in houses and mobile homes
- Over 55 decks and egress stairs rebuilt or repaired to provide a safe exit from home
- Over 30 flooring projects completed
- 15 mobile home roofs coated to protect from deterioration and seal minor leaks
- 13 ADA compliant wheelchair ramps constructed
- 7 shingle roofs replaced for protection from the elements
- 4 bathroom enhancements completed for safety, functionality, and access
- Major trash removal from several sites to ensure a safe living environment for residents
- Over 100 smoke detectors delivered to residents

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### **Cost:**

- St. Raymond's Parishioner: \$350/person. Non-Parishioner: \$525/person.

Your participation with our fundraising efforts (Movie/Babysitting Night & WorkCamp Raffle) is critical to keeping your total The total cost is actually \$525 /person but when you include the cost of rental vans, gas, food, preparation etc. it ends up costing close to cost to **\$350**.

### Fundraising:

- Fundraising helps to keep the parish informed of what we are doing and who is doing it.
- It also helps to cover the expense of our chaperones, rental vans, t-shirts, as well as other expenses, such as our team building day at Sportrock, supplies for our tool day, and much more.
- Most of the participant fee goes into purchasing the materials for home repairs. Some provides breakfast & dinner for the week & evening program costs.

### Community Building:
